How can I support the work of All Saints'?

Members of All Saints' contribute to the life and work of the church in many different ways. Whilst the information below relates to financial giving, other pages on our website explain the variety of ways you can get involved and contribute to All Saints' many ministries.

You can give regularly to All Saints' (Charity number 1128042). It helps us plan and budget for the ministry of the church if members can make a regular donation to the church through Planned Giving.

You may also wish to give an additional one-off thank offering or similar donation which may also be Gift Aided

Planned Giving

There are three ways to do this:

- By setting up a standing order with your bank if you would like details on how to set this up, please see enclosed form or contact John Rugg the Planned Giving Officer. <u>You need to</u> <u>discuss with John before setting up a standing order by internet</u> <u>or telephone to receive a unique reference.</u>
- Through your employer's payroll (GAYE) giving scheme (this only applies if your employer runs such a scheme – your Human Resources department can provide details on this).
- By using weekly or monthly envelopes which you put in the general collection using cash or cheque.

Other Ways to Give

- A collection is taken at all Sunday services.
- If you would like to send us a cheque or a gift by CAF or Stewardship voucher, please make it payable to All Saints' Church PCC, ask John Rugg for more information.
- You can give in the form of quoted shares and other securities (which entitles you to tax relief).
- You may also like to consider leaving a legacy to All Saints' in your will. Please ask your solicitor when you make or change your will, or ask us for more information (see our leaflet or website).

How can I increase the value my gift at no cost to myself? – Gift Aid

If you pay UK tax (Income or Capital Gains Tax) and would like us to be able to claim back the basic rate tax, you will need to fill in, sign and return to us an on-going Gift Aid Declaration (attached) and return to John Rugg if you have not done so already. The benefit to All Saints' is that it can recover the basic rate of income tax, currently 25p for each pound given. (If you pay higher rate tax, you may recover this through your own tax return.)
